### **ACCCIM SEMINAR ON CORPORATE CRIMINAL LIABILITY FOR CORRUPTION (SECTION 17A MACC ACT) (1-11-2019)**

The enforcement of Section 17A of the MACC Act 2009 will be effective from June 2020. Under the new provision, a commercial organisation could be prosecuted if a person associated with the organisation commits a corrupt act.

In view of this, ACCCIM will be organising the ACCCIM Seminar on Corporate Criminal Liability for Corruption (Section 17A MACC Act) on 1<sup>st</sup> November 2019 to introduce the Corporate Liability Provision and its implications to Directors, Partners and Management of Commercial Organisations so as to create awareness. The Seminar is co-organised by The Chinese Chamber of Commerce and Industry of Kuala Lumpur and Selangor (KLSCCCI) and Klang Chinese Chamber of Commerce and Industry (KCCCI).
